UNICAMILLUS

Saint Camillus International University of Health and Medical Sciences (UniCamillus) was recently established: the acknowledgment procedure of the University was concluded on January 4th, 2018 with the publication of the provisional MD n. 927 of 28/11/2017. The qualifications issued by UniCamillus are exactly the same as those issued by the other Italian public universities, and therefore, they are valid throughout the whole EU, pursuant to Directive 2005/36/CE and of Directive 2013/55/UE. Students and graduates from UniCamillus can apply for the qualification of the Educational Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates, since all eligibility requirements are met. The University has been included in the World Directory of Medical Schools, joint venture between the World Federation for Medical Education (WFME) and the Foundation for Advancement of International Medical Education and Research (FAIMER). The first academic year has started in November 2018.

UniCamillus - Saint Camillus International University of Health and Medical Sciences welcomes students from all over the world and trains them to become physicians or health professionals versatile and focused also on diseases of underprivileged countries. For this reason the University is addressed particularly to EU and non-EU students who show a humanitarian, scientific and professional interest in the health problems affecting especially the Developing countries.

The courses are aimed at training doctors and healthcare professionals capable of operating at an international level. In line with the international profile of the University UniCamillus, the degree courses are taught mainly in English. Educational tools and support programs help the student in improving his command of the language during the course, up to the achievement of a level that will allow him to use its qualification, with no language difficulties whatsoever, in most countries in the world.

SECOND LEVEL MASTER PROGRAM (Continuing Professional Development)

This program lasts for one academic year, during which students will acquire both theoretical knowledge and practical skills. The purpose of the Master Program (CPD Course) is to provide clinicians with necessary means for a correct diagnostic and operative approach to an ideal implant prosthetic rehabilitation. Students will be drawn into modern implantology from the diagnosis to the prosthetic rehabilitation and will have the chance to get in contact with the most modern surgical techniques and technologies.

The Master Program (CPD Course)'s main partner is Istituto Stomatologico Toscano (IST), chaired by Prof. Ugo Covani.



MASTER IN ORAL IMPLANTOLOGY A.Y. 2024 / 2025

The Master's Course Program in Oral Implantology is designed for the general dentist who has already taken the first step towards the field of implantology and wishing to develop their theoretical knowledge and practical clinical experience of treatment planning, surgical placement, restoration and maintenance of dental implants.

The programme aims to provide general practitioners with confidence in patient selection, diagnosis, treatment planning, and execution of straightforward implant cases. Apart from developing a good understanding of the biological basis of implant dentistry, the programme will provide supervised hands-on to allow dentists to safely carry out the surgical and restorative procedures, as well as design and execute the maintenance of patients with dental implants. The 12-months modular graduate degree program takes your time constraints and job responsibilities into consideration.

You have to travel four times to University center in Camaiore during your course of studies. Each stay lasting 5 days: you'll have lessons, hands-on courses and live surgeries thus grow through input from our international faculty, guest lectures and fellow students. The graduates will be able to independently plan and implement therapy concepts for the treatment of patients requiring dental implant prosthetics.

In addition, graduates will also have the skills required to select, analyse and fully integrate into their own practice a full range of treatments and knowledge in this field of dental implantology.

The course concludes with a Master's thesis on topics of implant that will prepare the student during the year and will discuss at the end of the course.

ATTENDENCE MODE

The attendance is mandatory for at least the 80% of the total hours of the Master Program (CPD Course).

The Master Program (CPD Course) is composed of 6 lectures in live webinar mode and 4 sessions of frontal lectures each lasting 5 days (Monday to Friday).

Three of the frontal sessions will be held in Lido di Camaiore and the fourth at Unicamillus University in Rome for the final examination and parchment award ceremony.

The didactic calendar may be subject to change in relation to national and international scientific calendars and the availability of teaching staff.

Upon activation of the Master Program (CPD Course) (after the deadline for enrollment) the final schedule will be sent out.

ADMISSION AND SELECTION CRITERIA

The application must be submitted via the GOMP student portal following instructions given in the GUIDE by 01st February 2025. In order to complete your application, you need to have the following documents, which must be attached to the student portal during the procedure:

- Curriculum Vitae et Studiorum in European format (in PDF format signed and dated)
- Identity document (in PDF format)
- Degree certificate (in pdf format);
- Personal Photo (maximum 30MB in .jpg or .png format)
- Photocopy of the Tax Code or Health Card (for Italian citizens and foreigners in possession);
 Payment of first installment.
- For candidates in possession of qualifications equivalent to those required:

• Declaration in lieu of certification, pursuant to art. 46 point m of D.P.R. 28/12/2000, no. 445, certifying the achievement of the qualifications in question, in accordance with current legislation.

• For candidates in possession of qualifications equivalent/equivalent to those required Dichiarazione di Valore in Loco issued by the Italian Consular Authority of the country of study (accompanied by transcript of records + copy of final diploma) or CIMEA Certificate of Comparability-Statement of correspondence (ARDI) accompanied by CIMEA Certificate of Verification (by accessing the CIMEA platform) or Diploma Supplement (if it is a European qualification) issued by the University of origin and legalised at the Italian Embassy in the country of study.

Conditional enrolment will not be accepted due to incomplete documentation or incorrect entry of data on the application form. Following admission, candidates will have to follow the enrolment procedure following the indications provided in the appropriate guide, which will be sent by email together with the notification of admission to the Master Program (CPD Course)'s course.

ACCESS REQUIREMENT

. Master's Degree in "Dentistry and Dental Prosthesis" or other equivalent qualification class LM-46;EQF: 7.

. Master's Degree in "Medicine and Surgery" or other equivalent qualification class LM-41;EQF: 7.

Candidates in possession of an academic qualification obtained abroad, equivalent in duration and content to those listed above, can apply as well.

In the latter case, candidates must provide Declaration of Value, issued by the Italian Consular Authority of the country of study (together with "Transcript of Records" + duplicate of final degree) or CIMEA Statements of Comparability along with CIMEA Statements of Verification (through CIMEA platform) or Diploma Supplement (in case of European Degrees) issued by the University of origin and legalized by the Italian Embassy of the country of study.

<u>Candidates who do not have or do not present by the first day of class the requirements laid</u> <u>down in the regulations in force, forfeit their enrollment if already admitted and have no right to</u> <u>refunds of any amount paid to the University.</u>

In case of lacking of the aforementioned requirements, Didactic Administrative Office can exclude candidates from the Master at any time and with a justified provision.

VALUE OF THE MASTER TITLE

A Master Degree is a high level post-graduate scientific programme. The Master involve the acquisition of at least 60 university learning credit (ECTS) .

The second level Master's Degree represents from a classification point of view a course of study of the third cycle of the Bologna process / Level 8 EQF.
